SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Approve Permissive Parachute Jumping

1. References:

2. In accordance with references above, authority to act on permissive parachute jump requests is hereby delegated to subordinate organization senior commanders within TRADOC exercising General Court-Martial Convening Authority.

3. Requests for permissive parachuting status for general officers and promotable colonels will be forwarded for action through CG, TRADOC and General Officer Management Office for action by the Vice Chief of Staff, Army. Requests for members of the Personnel Exchange Program, foreign area officers, and schools of other nations will be forwarded through the CG, TRADOC for action by HQDA, DCS, G-3/5/7 (DAMO-SSF).

4. Commanders will follow all prerequisites and procedures contained in the references above for Soldiers requesting permissive parachute jumping.
