2. This policy letter supersedes memorandum, HQ TRADOC, ATFC-Y, 02 October 2006, subject: Coordination Requirements for Foreign Engagements.


3. TRADOC will provide relevant and high-quality security cooperation support to our globally responsive and regionally engaged geographic combatant commands (GCC) and Army service component commands (ASCC). The expertise and capabilities resident in TRADOC are vital to efforts to build partner capacity, trust, and access around the world. TRADOC provides institutional support for security cooperation through numerous engagements with foreign officials, both here and abroad. We will conduct all foreign engagements by, with, or through the ASCCs, providing them full visibility over our security cooperation activities in accordance with the references above.

4. TRADOC organizations will notify ARCIC's International Army Programs Directorate (IAPD) and the appropriate ASCC staff elements prior to any general officer/senior executive service-level engagement with senior foreign officials. Where possible, plan and execute your engagement to create synergy with GCC/ASCC efforts.

5. IAPD staff will assist you in contacting the appropriate personnel at the ASCC. They can also assist you with linking your engagement goals and objectives with theater campaign plans and Army Campaign support plans. TRADOC liaison officers assigned to IAPD and located at ASCCs and select foreign countries will help focus and facilitate your engagement.
