**GOAL 1: PROVIDE PREVENTION SERVICES THAT CONTRIBUTE TO ARMY OUTCOMES  
(Community Cohesion, Safety, Self-Sufficiency, Personnel Preparedness)**

- Objective 1: Establish primary and secondary prevention programs aimed at target population Based on community needs.
- Objective 2: Market services to enhance program delivery and increase participation of target Population.
- Objective 3: Develop MOUs and partnerships with installation departments, joint service FAP, and civilian agencies for the most effective and efficient use of recourses.
- Objective 4: Increase level of participation by service members.
- Objective 5: Ensure that all programs are sensitive to culture, race, gender, and physical disabilities.
- Objective 6: Develop and implement a needs assessment.

**GOAL 2: ENHANCE THE QUALITY AND AVAILABILITY OF DIRECT SERVICES**

- Objective 1: Ensure that Victim Advocacy Services are offered to all victims of spouse abuse.
- Objective 2: Expand the availability of treatment services for victims of child and spouse abuse.
- Objective 3: Pursue MOUs with Langley AF Family Advocacy Program and community agencies for increased participation in couples support.

**GOAL 3: ADMINISTER PROGRAM TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH DoD AND ARMY FAP STANDARDS**

- Objective 1: Maintain budget at current or increased funding level to maintain current services.
- Objective 2: Meet or exceed all DoD and Army FAP standards.
- Objective 3: Become fully accredited by 2003.
- Objective 4: Meet all requirements to higher headquarters and contribute to the QA of the DA FAP.
- Objective 5: Fully utilize technology to enhance program marketing, training, education, and communication.

**GOAL 4: ENSURE TRAINED STAFF**

- Objective 1: Ensure that all professionals are thoroughly trained IAW their FAP responsibilities outlined in AR 608-18.
- Objective 2: Provide continuing education program for all Family Advocacy personnel.
- Objective 3: Supervise and provide training for all volunteers working within FAP programs.

**GOAL 5: INTEGRATE RESEARCH AND PROGRAM EVALUATION INTO ALL FAP PROGRAMMING**

- Objective 1: Establish an effective and efficient accountability and monitoring system for FAP.
- Objective 2: Participate in Army-wide FAP research.
- Objective 3: Base programs and services on community needs assessments, demographics, and sound research.
- Objective 4: Work toward utilizing process outcome evaluation to evaluate existing programs and determine resource allocation.
