

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
U.S. ARMY GARRISON, FORT MONMOUTH AND
THE NEW JERSEY VIETNAM VETERANS OF AMERICA

SUBJECT: Use of Morale, Welfare and Recreation Facilities

1. This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is entered into by and between the U.S. Army Garrison, Morale Welfare and Recreation Directorate, Fort Monmouth, New Jersey and the New Jersey Vietnam Veterans of America (NJVVA).
2. Purpose: The Purpose of this MOA is to approve and establish terms and Conditions for the NJVVA use of the Fort Monmouth EXPO Theater, and the West Theater Parking Lot on August 25th 2001 (rain date September 1st 2001) From 0600 till 1800.
3. The area will be used to conduct the NJVVA 3rd annual Classic car show, an event that will be open to the General public
4. Reference: this Agreement is established within the guidelines of AR 215-1, Table 6-1, Morale, Welfare and Recreation.
5. Understanding:
 - a. The NJVVA will pay Fort Monmouth Morale, Welfare and Recreation Fund (FMMWRF) a fee of \$3000.00 for use of the West Theater Parking Lot Payable 72 hours before the Date of the Event.
 - b. The NJVVA will pre-register the show cars and charge a fee to each party that will display their vehicle. The NJVVA will also conduct a 50/50 raffle and a silent auction of donated products and services. The NJVVA will print up programs and offer ads in the program by way of donations to NJVVA. (Fort Monmouth FMMWRF reserves the right to approve all ads in this program). The NJVVA will also sell shirts and pins that display the event (final approval of all designs thru FMMWRF)
 - c. NJVVA will provide volunteers to help with parking and direction at the event
6. Understanding:
 - a. FMMWRF will provide use of the Expo Theater restrooms, outside stage and West Theater Parking Lot on the dates stated.
 - b. FMMWRF will provide contracted Food Vendors on the day of the event
 - c. FMMWRF will provide trash cans at various locations during the event and pickup of trash after the event
 - d. FMMWRF will ask for support from PMO for Traffic control during the event
 - e. The NJVVA will agree to Hold Harmless The Fort Monmouth Morale, Welfare and Recreation Directorate, the U. S Army Garrison Fort Monmouth and the United States Army, or the United States Government its Officers, Agent, Directors and Employees if the Event is Cancelled or Rescheduled.

7. Hold Harmless

- a. The NJVVA will provide a liability Insurance policy in the amount of \$3,000,000.00 at the signing of this MOA.
- b. The NJVVA its agents, officers, directors and employees agree to perform these activities at their own risk and in consideration for using these facilities, will not hold the FMMWRF, the Fort Monmouth U.S. Army Garrison, the United States Army or the United States Government or any of their officers, agents, directors or employees liable for injuries, damage or losses.
