

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN  
U.S. ARMY GARRISON FORT MONMOUTH AND  
STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW AND PUBLIC SAFETY  
DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE

SUBJECT: Use of Morale, Welfare and Recreation Facilities

1. This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) is entered into by and between the U.S. Army Garrison, Morale, Welfare and Recreation Directorate, Fort Monmouth, New Jersey and the Division of Criminal Justice Academy. (DCJ Academy).
2. Purpose: The Purpose of this MOA is to approve and establish terms and conditions for the DCJ Academy's use of Fort Monmouth, Lane Hall or the Community Center, on October 1<sup>st</sup> through October 5<sup>th</sup> 2001, from 0800 to 1700 each day. The charge for this facility is \$75.00 per day, payable to FMMWRF a minimum of 72 hours before the Training class begins.
3. Reference: This agreement is established within the guidelines of AR-215-1 Table 6-1, Morale, Welfare and Recreation.
4. Understanding:
  - a. DCJ Academy understands that if Fort Monmouth is closed due to inclement weather on a scheduled training day, DCJ Academy will re-schedule training for another day.
5. Hold-harmless provisions. The DCJ Academy, its agents, officers, directors and employees agree to perform these activities at their own risk and, in consideration for using these facilities, will not hold the Fort Monmouth Morale, Welfare and Recreation directorate, the Fort Monmouth Army Garrison, the United States Government or any of their officers, agents, directors or employees liable for harmless agreement before such activities begin.
6. This agreement is effective 1 March 2001.
