SUBJECT: CECOM Policy Memo #03-03, Authority and Jurisdiction of the Directorate for Public Safety and Fort Monmouth Police

1. PURPOSE. To establish the Command's policy to maintain law and order on Fort Monmouth.
2. APPLICABILITY. This policy applies to all civilian and military personnel assigned or attached to CECOM and Fort Monmouth.
3. POLICY.
 - a. In accordance with (IAW) applicable law and regulations, Fort Monmouth police personnel are authorized to apprehend and detain individuals subject to the Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), as well as any person on the installation who is apprehended for generally serious offenses.
 - b. Fort Monmouth police personnel, the Deputy Director, the Operations Officer, and credentialed physical security inspectors, operating under the direction of the Fort Monmouth Director for Public Safety, are authorized to act, apprehend and detain any individual subject to UCMJ, upon reasonable belief that an offense has been committed or is being committed and that the person apprehended committed it. This includes the authority to apprehend deserters from the Armed Forces in accordance with Article 8, UCMJ.
 - c. Additionally, those individuals stated above are authorized to apprehend and detain any person found on the installation for offenses committed on post that are felonies, breaches of the peace, motor vehicle violations or otherwise a threat to property, life or welfare.
 - d. Apprehension authority is for any civilian offender(s) found on the installation based upon probable cause and reasonable belief that the person being detained committed an offense upon the installation. Civilian personnel shall be detained only for a reasonable period of time for processing the issuance of citations, or turned over to appropriate civilian or federal law enforcement authorities.
