

**FORT MONMOUTH**  
**MWR**  
**RISK MANAGEMENT PLAN** **3/02**

The Fort Monmouth MWR Risk Management Plan is composed of two major elements: Risk Management Program and Risk Management Control.

(I) The Risk Management Program, developed from AR 215-1, 14-4-

1. RIMP follows the general principles of the commercial insurance industry in administering a self-insurance program.

RIMP maintains a database of insured assets, employees, and payroll. As coverage needs of NAFIs are identified, RIMP provides the coverage either through the self insured program or a commercial insurance company.

2. RIMP Invoices NAF Activities for the cost of insurance and maintains reserves to pay claims.

Losses from the ACIF. Other than claims processed under the provisions of AR 27-20, general provisions of the insurance industry are used in adjusting claims.

RIMP maintains data on loss history and advises NAFI managers of losses that could be prevented or reduced with proper attention to loss and accident prevention measures.

Insurance policies are not issued under this program. Annually each fund manager will correct statements of insured exposures to update the RIMP database.

**PUBLIC SAFETY**


1. PMO- Provides security, Traffic Control, & Crowd Control
2. Safety Office- Provides training in spotting hazards
3. DPW- Provides Fire inspections and Fire Control
4. EEO- Provides protection from workplace Discrimination

**HEALTH**

1. Preventative Medicine- Provides health, sanitation inspections and recall notices.
2. Safety- Provides training and site inspection of facilities and sites
3. MWR- Provides training of staff

**INTERVENTION**

1. PMO- Provides Public Security, crowd and traffic control, anti-terrorism, and law enforcement.
2. Fire Department- provides EMS and Fire Rescue

  
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
