

The Army School System (TASS)

FOR THE COMMANDER:

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History. This is an administrative revision change 1 to U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) Regulation (Reg) 350-18, 3 April 2007.

Summary. This TRADOC Reg 350-18 prescribes policies and defines The Army School System (TASS), to include specific TASS policy and guidance. This administrative revision corrects references and typographical errors in paragraphs 3-6, 3-32, and C-4.

Applicability. This regulation applies to U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) schools, Active Army (AA), Army National Guard (ARNG), and U.S. Army Reserve (USAR) agencies responsible for conducting education and training courses.

Proponent and exception authority. The proponent of this regulation is the Deputy Chief of Staff, G-3/5/7, Director, Reserve Component Training Integration Directorate (RCTID). The proponent has the authority to approve exceptions or waivers to this regulation that are consistent with controlling law and regulation. The proponent may delegate this approval authority in writing when activities request a waiver.

Army management control process. This regulation is subject to the requirements of Army Regulation (AR) 11-2.

Supplementation. Supplementation of this regulation and establishment of command and local forms are prohibited without prior approval from the Director, RCTID (ATTG-X), 355 Fenwick Road, Bldg 260, Fort Monroe, VA 23651.

Suggested improvements. The proponent of this regulation is the Director, RCTID. Forward comments and suggested improvements on DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) through channels to Director, RCTID (ATTG-X), 355 Fenwick Road, Bldg 260, Fort Monroe, VA 23651. Suggested improvements may also be submitted using DA Form 1045 (Army Ideas for Excellence Program (AIEP) Proposal).

Summary of Change

Change 1, dated 28 December 2007.

Change TRADOC Reg 350-18, 3 April 2007, as follows-

1. In contents, change paragraph title to read: 3-6 Military Occupational Specialty Training.
2. In paragraph 3-6, change paragraph title to read: Military Occupational Specialty Training.
3. In paragraph 3-32b(1), change the first sentence to read: The training supervisor will advise the student that an appeal must be submitted within 7 duty days following receipt of written notification of the dismissal action IAW AR 350-1, paragraph 3-18e(1).
4. In paragraph 3-32b(2), change first sentence to read: The student will acknowledge by endorsement within 2 duty days receipt of the written notification of dismissal action IAW AR 350-1, paragraph 3-18e(2).
5. In paragraph C-4, part II Routine Prerequisites, change “*Meets color vision requirements*” to read: Enter only for MOS-T (reclassification) courses if the course requires a color vision requirement IAW DA Pam 611-21 in the regulation data column and Soldier’s color vision as per DD Form 2808 or applicable color vision testing in the Soldier data column.
6. In paragraph C-4, part II Routine Prerequisites, change “*Physical demand rating/profile*” to read: Enter PULHES data per DA Pam 611-21 (or current published requirements at (<https://perscomnd04.army.mil/MOSMARTBK.nsf/>) for all courses/phases. IAW AR 350-1, paragraph 3-11b, Soldiers with a P2 profile requiring an alternate APFT event or other course accommodation must include a copy of DA Form 3349 with the PEC and Soldiers with a P3 or

P4 profile must include a copy of the DA Form 3349 and the results of their MMRB with the PEC.

7. In paragraph C-4, part III Required Documents, change “*Security Clearance*” to read: Enter “yes” if required for course and attach copy or security manager verification of clearance to PEC.

8. Add abbreviation to the glossary: PEC pre-execution checklist.
